A3 4 Life – Centers for Disease Control Act Against AIDS Leadership Initiative & National Campaign to Prevent Teen and Unplanned Pregnancy

As a recipient of more than \$400,000 in grant funding from the Centers for Disease Control for the implementation of an HIV/AIDS education and prevention program and the National Campaign to Prevent Teen and Unplanned Pregnancy to educate young girls and teens on positive self-imaging and healthy behavior, the sorority may from time to time offer instruction in high-level HIV and AIDS information and education and other human sexuality information. Instruction may also include the recognition, prevention, and treatment of sexually transmitted disease. This instruction shall stress that abstinence from sex is a responsible and effective method of preventing unplanned or out of wedlock pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease and is a positive lifestyle for unmarried young people.

Rhoer Club Criteria

The Rhoer Club Criteria is based on the following areas: Conduct, Participation, Dress and Attendance.

- **Conduct:** Respect yourself and others
- **Participation:** Be active
- **Dress:** Your attire should reflect a lady of elegance

Wear appropriate attire to meetings and activities

Do wear dress pants, blouse, skirt, or dress for meetings or any sorority informal/formal function

Do wear your Rhoer Club t-shirts (if applicable) to activities

Do not wear jeans, sneakers, sweats, athletic wear to activities unless specified
- **Attendance:** Attend all meetings and activities, call your advisor if you are unable to attend a meeting or activity. This should be done no later than 24 hours prior to an activity.

Requirements

- Recommendation:** One letter of recommendation
- Scholastic Achievement:** G.P.A. must be a 2.5 or greater on a 4.0 scale

Rhoer Club Membership Kit Rhoer Club Guidelines

The Rhoer Club is an affiliate of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. All members of the Rhoer Club must conduct themselves according to the Rhoer Club Handbook and any criteria established. Please be diligent in the adherence of the guidelines below.

- Be on time. The Rhoer Club meets (date, time and location). Any Rhoer more than fifteen (15) minutes late will be assessed 5 (five) points and fined 25¢ for their lateness.
- Contact your Rhoer Advisor if you will be absent. Your Rhoer advisor must be contacted at least 24 hours before any Rhoer meeting or activity. Excessive unexcused absences take away from ALL club members' learning experience, including yours. Unexcused absence –10 points (not calling advisor); Excused absence –5 (calling advisor).
- Be considerate of our time together. Disruptions will not be permitted! Rhoer Club meetings should be spent learning new ideas, sharing thoughts and having fun. It is disrespectful to hold side conversations when there is someone speaking. All disruptions will be noted by your Rhoer Advisor and by the Rhoer Sergeant-At-Arms. Any Rhoer receiving three (3) disruption warnings during a single session (meetings, community service activity, bonding activity, social activity, etc.) will receive –30 points.
- Fighting, Profanity, Alcohol, Illegal Substances and any act of Violence **will not** be tolerated. Any Rhoer observed fighting or using profanity can be dismissed from the Rhoer Club and a conference meeting will be held with parent(s) or guardian(s) regarding the matter before any further involvement with the Rhoer Club can occur.
- All adults will be addressed as Ms., Miss, Mrs., or Mr. (only members of the sorority can call members of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. SOROR)
- Be Well Dressed. This requires more sense than dollars. Always do your best. Your total appearance represents you.
- Rhoer Club members must wear business casual attire when speaker/guests are invited to an activity (unless specified by your advisor).
- Rhoer Club members wear Rhoer t-shirts (if applicable) for all community service projects and activities (unless specified by your advisor).
- Rhoer Club members must wear a dress or suit for group pictures (unless otherwise specified by advisor).
- Rhoer Club members must wear a dress or suit at the Regional conferences and Boule (unless specified by the Regional Rhoer Coordinator/ National Rhoer Coordinator).
- All new Rhoer Club Members must wear a white dress/suit (no pants) for the Rhoer Club Induction Ceremony.
- Transcripts are a must. Each Rhoer must submit a copy of their transcript after each semester or quarter, whichever applies to your school system.

Rhoer Club Membership Kit Code of Conduct and Discipline

The Rhoer Club seeks to maintain an environment that is conducive to learning and free from unnecessary disruption. Rhoer Club members are expected to behave in such a way that their presence does not detract from their own educational benefit or other's educational benefit. Rhoer Club members shall treat fellow Rhoers, Advisors, Sorority members, and other affiliate members of the sorority with dignity and respect.

A Rhoer may be removed from the club if she engages in one or more of the following activities:

- Lying or giving false information
- Committing a crime or an act of inappropriate conduct such as, but not limited to:
 - Fighting in School
 - Truancy
 - Robbery
 - Stealing
- Scholastic dishonesty (cheating)
- Continued willful disobedience or open and persistent defiance of Advisors, Sorority Members, and other affiliate members of the sorority. This includes deliberate refusal to obey any adult.
